Special Needs Resource Foundation of San Diego's mission is to help parents and advocates in the special needs community overcome challenges of the family's journey by bringing together people, information and resources. The idea? Local people from the special needs community came to our for-profit company, San Diego Family, and asked for help. There were many resources available in the community but they were not accumulated or accessible in a single resource. The community wanted and needed one collective place to access resources. We wanted to help, so we accepted this challenge and created the annual publication Flourishing Families. For convenience, we also posted these resources online. Advocates use Flourishing Families to inform parents of the resources available in the community and to point them in the right direction for help. In January 2014, we filed as a CA nonprofit, Special Needs Resource Foundation of San Diego.
